


Adopt a Child/Teacher in Liberia, West Africa




- *Imagine \$10 a month pays the tuition of a war victimized child.*

School Relations Program

The School Relationship program primary goal is to establish partnerships with schools in the United States. It is our hope that Bong Education Center Students develop lifelong pen pals with students in the United States. BEC will facilitate pen pal relationships by matching students and guaranteeing that letters are delivered. This program will enlighten the minds of BEC and United States students in the areas of the world never imagined.

The program also endeavors to reach out to colleges in the United States with the hope of developing scholarship programs for outstanding BEC students or linking students and teachers to available scholarships for international students. BEC will assist students with identifying international students' friendly colleges and assist with processing required documents.



The Supplies Program

The Supplies project seeks to encourage schools in the United States to donate the thousands of books school districts destroy yearly. Once books are donated, members of BEC examine, store, pack, and ship books to Bong Mines, Liberia. The books are shipped in containers or barrels paid for by donors like you.

Schools that have a partnership relationship with BEC are also encouraged to ship books directly. Schools request each grade to donate education supplies such as pencils, pens, papers, erasers, and refurbished computers. Once the supplies are collected, the school administrator in consultation with a BEC member in the United States, will arrange to mail supplies to Liberia.

Education supplies taken for granted in affluent countries are treasured by students in Bong Mines, West Africa.

This project involves the financial support of students and teachers, establishing partnership relationships with schools in the United States, and processing educational supplies for shipment to Liberia.


